



ENVIRONMENTAL ETHOS

Greenwich Studios is working with BAFTA (in line with Albert certification) to become one of the first environmentally friendly film studios in the UK.

We favour LED lighting at the studio and have even considered sustainability in the renovations...for example the palm trees from which our state of the art acoustic wall panelling is milled are coconut palms that no longer yield fruit. We have also raided salvage yards to up-cycle scaffolding planks for panelling in the bathroom, and have a wonderful collection of midcentury vintage furniture pieces from local curiosity shops.

We have a facility company onsite able to accommodate every shoot requirement, once more limiting the production's carbon footprint by cutting back on delivery and collections.

All our vans meet the Euro 6 emissions standard and emit one of the lowest CO2 emission levels. This is lower than most other vans.

Thanks to Good Energy we are supplied with 100% renewable power and try to protect the oceans by providing filtered tap water - so you can save pennies and cut back on those pesky water bottles!

Fun Fact: Not one item of waste from Greenwich Studios goes to landfill - we recycle it all and that which is not recycled is burnt for biofuel.
